Thursday 2nd July saw very successful Junior and Senior swimming galas. Every pupil in the prep school swam in at least 2 races.

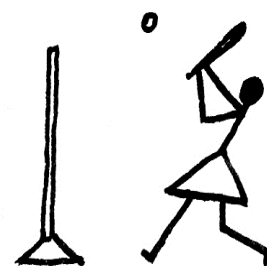

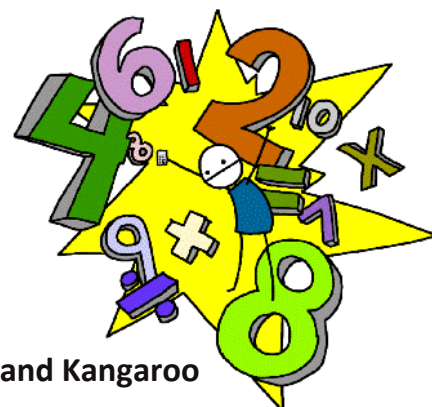
