UNIFORM SHOP

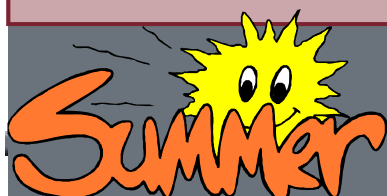
The uniform shop will be open on **1st & 6th September** between **2.00-4.00pm**.

Green Goblins—Goodwood

On Sunday fifteen intrepid Green Goblin drivers assembled at the world famous Goodwood motor racing circuit for the largest Gathering of the Goblins to date with 96 cars on the grid. Despite foul weather we prepared both cars and sailed through scrutineering – we knew we had some good cars and we were eager to get racing. The first event we elected to do was the pit stop challenge. Six members of the Blue Demon team were the first team ever to do this new event. All four wheels had to be removed and refitted all against the clock. The Blue Demon's got the unofficial World Record at 1 minute 54s! The Red Devil team listened to the feedback and pitched in a time of 1 minute 53s. The game was afoot.



The first driving event was the slalom. The course was soaking wet, cars were understeering left and right, cones were being knocked flying but both teams kept at it and posted some very quick times. Disaster struck the Blue Demon car as the drive belt snapped halfway through a very challenging run. Luckily Mr Hughes is a wiz at changing the belt and had the car up and running within minutes. The track and weather remained stubbornly wet, but all the practice on a slippery astro paid off and this time the Blue Demon team took honours with a quickest time of 11s compared to the Red Devil's 13s.

Both teams now moved to the drag race, head-to-head races against two other cars but it was the time that ultimately decided the overall winner. The Red Devil car was on fire and dominated its six timed runs. The drivers of the Blue Demon car were reporting an odd knocking sound and upon investigation discovered the small drive cog had come loose. Despite some valiant bodging, the cog refused to co-operate; the Blue Demon car was wounded and it showed in the drag results. Another new event for Goodwood was a relay drag race where both teams ended up with three other schools and had to race as a group. Both teams rose to the challenge and despite some last minute doubts they both ran beautifully.

The big event was now upon us. One lap of the Goodwood circuit, all 2.4 miles. The cars had a timing transponder fitted so again time was what we were racing against, just also happened to have 96 cars on the track at the same time. The cars were released in waves of four and soon both cars were off down the pit straight and the Red Devil pulled effortlessly away from the Blue Demon and all other cars around it. As parents and spectators watched the cars disappear around the circuit all we could do was wait and listen to the tannoy for incidents or breakdowns. In no time at all the first of the front runners came whispering past. Despite nearly 10 minutes of driving cars were still fighting for track position on the final straight. Then we saw the Red Devil hove into view well ahead from its starting position. What a result. Where was the Blue Demon? Had the drive cog held on? Finally the car came around the final bend and juddered across the finish line. The car had doggedly held on but the damage was now terminal, she will not be running again.

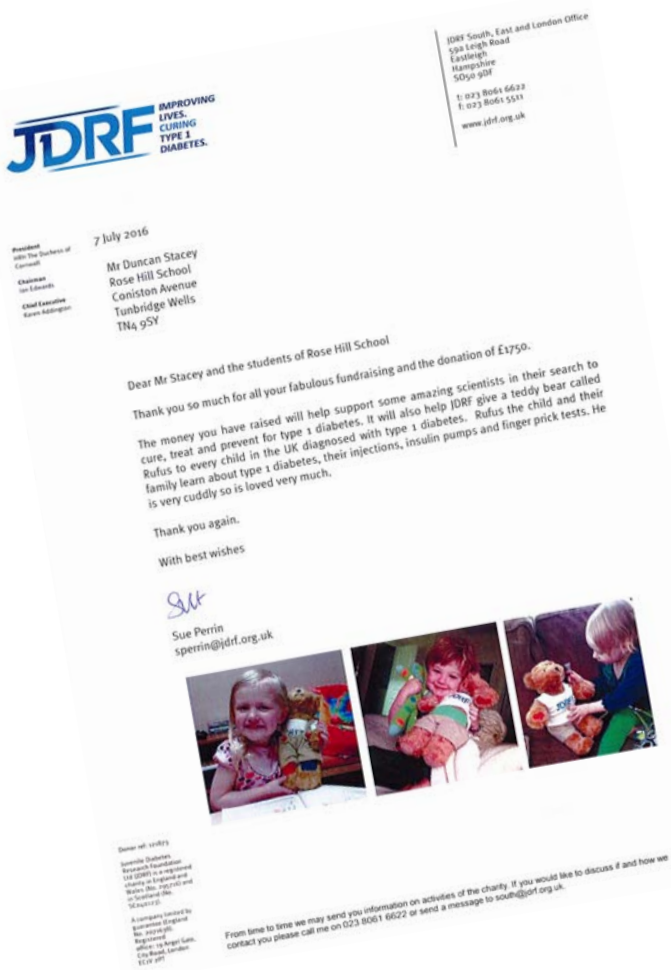

An unofficial position for the final lap around Goodwood had the Red Devil 11th fastest. The excellent performance of both cars is the result of hard work by the children and staff over the whole season.
