### UNIFORM AND PE KIT

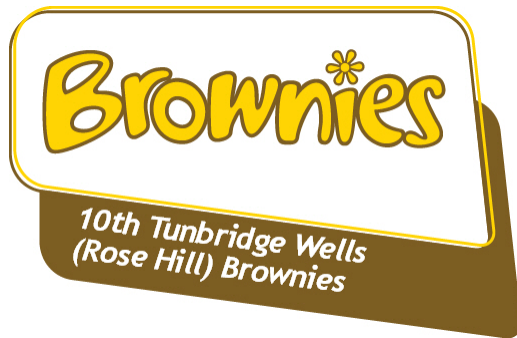
