NOTE FROM THE HEAD



I would like to warmly welcome you all back to the Autumn Term here at Rose Hill School. For some parents this will be your first Rose Hill newsletter, this is something which we produce on a weekly basis keeping you informed about the school calendar, activities and important messages .

It has been a very busy first few days back but I am so pleased to see the school come back to life after the long summer break. A very warm welcome to all the new families who are joining us this year. If you are new to the school, please make a note of Friday 15 September when the Parents' Association will be hosting a New Parents' Breakfast from 8.30am in the dining room. If you are a current parent who would like to hear about the PA or would like to meet some new parents, come and join us, please let the [office](#) know you are coming so we can cater accordingly.

The school has remained very busy throughout the summer, with the activity holidays and the swimming pool development. Work on the pool has gathered pace and the main building frame and walls are in place, along with the mains services. The project remains on track for completion early February 2018.

A reminder that summer uniform should be worn until half-term, unless advised otherwise.

After School Care: the 'morning session' runs from 8.00-8.25am in the Octagon. Children who are not collected at the end of the school day go to the Octagon where they are supervised until 4.00pm - the 'early session'. However, for those children who are staying later, the After School Care 'late session' begins at 4.00pm in the KW classroom and runs until 5.15pm.

To guarantee a place these must be made a term in advance and are booked using the online booking form found on the school [website](#) The After School Care agreement also needs to be completed and returned to the school office before your child's first session. Occasional bookings can be requested twelve hours in advance using the after school care email afterschoolcare@rosehillschool.co.uk. However, places can't be guaranteed and will be dependent on availability.

Keeping Pupils Safe... Part of the Government's Keeping Children Safe In Education (KCSIE) legislation focuses on online safety. At school, we spend some time advising our pupils about making the right choices. A recent survey showed that 65% of 8 – 11 year olds own a smartphone or tablet. How do you protect them from online dangers? In school we will be revisiting our 'Acceptable Use Policy' (AUP) with pupils, a copy of which is enclosed in the Pupils Planner for pupils in the Lower and Upper Schools.

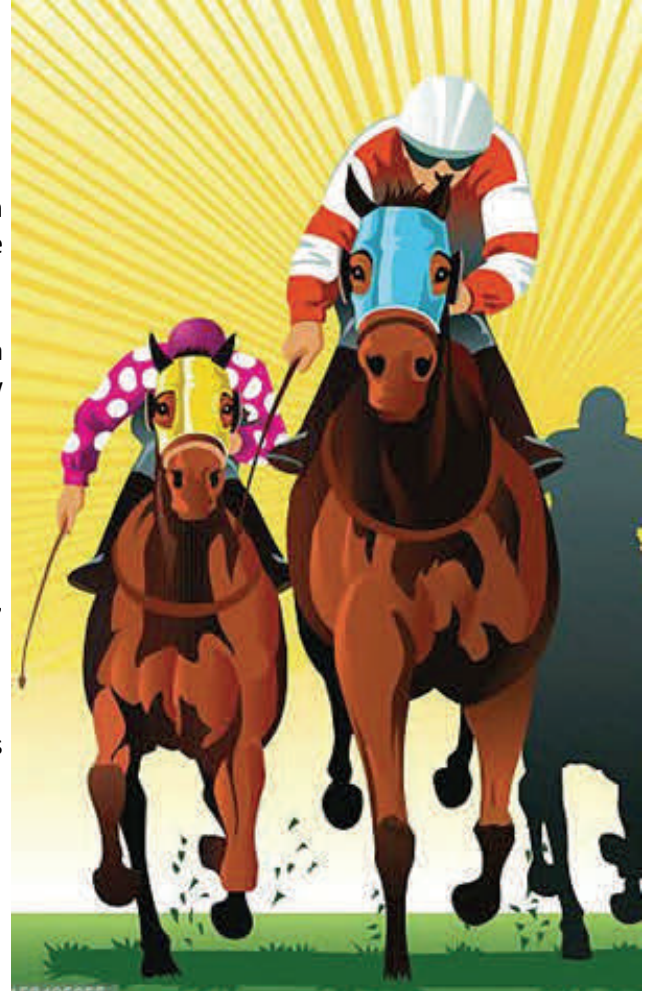
We'd like to take this early opportunity to introduce you to a ****NEW**** PA event taking place this year and in only a few weeks time!
